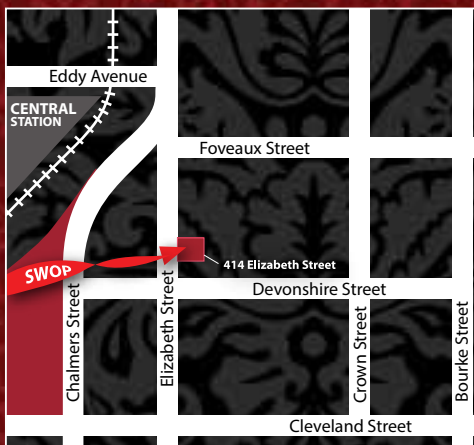

- sex for food, drugs or a place to stay

Female, male and transgender sex workers from all backgrounds, cultures, sexualities and countries are welcome.

## **Who we are**

SWOP is a community organisation, run by and for sex workers in NSW.

We provide peer education, and sexual health information and support services with a focus on HIV, STI and Hepatitis C prevention and education.

We outreach to sex industry workplaces throughout metro, regional and rural NSW. We work with sex workers and management to keep safer sex practices, and workplace health and safety at a high level.
